

GAS SAFETY (MANAGEMENT) REGULATIONS 1996 DIRECTION TO STOP USING GAS PURSUANT TO REGULATION 6(4)

SGN, as the conveyor of gas in the network connected to your premises, hereby directs you to stop consuming gas at any firm and interruptible gas supply points on your premises as soon after time on shown above as it is safe to do so without danger to life and not consume gas again for 28 days from the date and time of this notice or until authorised to do so by SGN.

This direction in accordance with regulation 6(5) is given in order to prevent one or more supply emergencies and you are required to comply with this direction pursuant to regulation 6(6) of the above regulations.

This is also a notice to cease using gas under your supply contract in a pipe-line system emergency as defined in Standard Condition 14 of the Suppliers Licence and Standard Condition 5 of the Shippers Licence.

If consumption of gas is not discontinued gas supplies to domestic and priority consumers such as hospitals may be at risk and the conveyor of gas in the network may take steps to physically disconnect your gas supply outside your premises which subsequently may result in a delay in reconnecting your premises to the relevant network.

Failure to comply with this direction may result in criminal prosecution by the Health & Safety Executive and a copy of this direction notice will be passed to the Health & Safety Executive.

You must not resume the consumption of gas for 28 days or until told to do so by an authorised SGN's officer.
